We welcome staff for training programmes in many different fields every year, from specialist courses to tailor made programmes.



Our courses are divided into two modules; Refresher programmes for international teachers and Specialist seminars. All courses consist of 20 lessons (15 hours) of English for Teachers and 10 lessons (7.5 hours) of specialist seminars.



All teachers receive detailed reports, as well as a certificate of attainment, upon course completion.



We are experienced in working with Erasmus+ and Europass Mobility (KA1) funding, and are happy to help with all necessary paperwork.



Prices vary, but the cost of a typical one-week training course is £480. We offer discounts for group bookings. Please contact us for a personalised quotation.

Entry pathways

- 1. For self-funded international teachers, educational managers and trainee teachers from both within and outside the European Union, Scandinavia and Turkey.
- 2. Erasmus+. Applicants are eligible for European Commission grants, and must be nationals of the European Union, Scandinavia or Turkey. Applications for financial support can be made through the National Erasmus Agency of the participant.

Online merge offline (OMO) programmes

All teachers' programmes are offered online, or by blended learning. Tuition for those teachers taking lessons remotely continues to be "live", since the teaching is bespoke, and does not consist of pre-recorded lessons or 'study guides', which can often be easily be bought online. Each course is designed around the individual student.

Course Content

The course is aimed at trainee or practising teachers of English and other subjects, who wish to develop their language and teaching skills further.

Course structure:

- 20 English for Teaching lessons at 15 hours of tuition
- 10 Specialist Seminars at 7.5 hours of tuition
- School and University visits
- Visits to suppliers of educational resources

The course includes:

- Developing command of written and spoken English and building confidence in using English in the classroom
- Grammar clinics
- Vocabulary and pronunciation
- Reading, writing, listening and speaking skills
- Classroom activities
- Using games and music in the classroom
- Optional sessions in English Literature and Culture
- Planning effective lessons
- Observation of lessons at various levels

- Improved your classroom and presentational skills
- Improved your own language skills
